Horse and Rider combination must have competed in the Grand Prix competition at either 2007 Saddleworld Dressage Festival or 2007 Sydney CDI 3-Star to be eligible to vie for the jackpot prize money available to the 4 highest aggregate scorers when the score from either Sydney or Melbourne is added to the Grand Prix score achieved at the Hyfeed 2007 Toowoomba Dressage Championships. Highest overall scoring combination will receive trophy rug, \$2000 cash and a Hyfeed Automatic feeder and be named 2007 Hyfeed Grand Prix Tournament Champion.

QUEENSLAND YOUNG RIDER COMMITTEE 2007 CDI-Y TOURNAMENT CHAMPION

Horse and Rider combination must have competed in the CDI-Y competition at either 2007 Saddleworld Dressage Festival or 2007 Sydney CDI 3-Star to be eligible to vie for the jackpot prize money available to the 4 highest aggregate scorers when the score from either Sydney or Melbourne is added to the CDI-Y score achieved at the Hyfeed 2007 Toowoomba Dressage Championships. Highest overall scoring combination will receive trophy rug, rosette and be named Queensland Young Rider Committee 2007 CDI-Y Tournament Champion.

Thursday evening Welcome BBQ

There will be a welcome BBQ for riders and their supporters held on Thursday evening after the rider's forum in the indoor arena spectator area. All riders, grooms and horse owners are invited to attend to meet the officials and judges for the event as well as the major sponsors. Cost for the BBQ is \$5 per person to be paid at the door, BYO drinks.

Ticketing

No admission fee will be charged for general entry onto the grounds throughout the Championships. A \$5 admission will be charged for spectators to the indoor arena on Saturday evening. There will be a large program of entertainment on Friday and Saturday evening in the indoor and tables and chairs will be set up along the 'E' side of the arena for VIP seating with full table service. Tickets for VIP seats must be booked and paid for in advance. There will be a limited amount of allocated reserve seating available in the grand stand behind 'E'.

- § VIP tickets for Friday evening include wine, beer and non-alcoholic beverages and finger food. Cost of tickets is \$35/person.
- § VIP tickets for Saturday evening will include full 3 course meal plus drinks (wine/beer/soft drink). Cost \$75/person
- § 2 Day VIP ticket (Fri and Sat evenings as above) Cost \$100/person
- § Reserved seating behind 'E' for Saturday evening \$15/person.

Tickets can be booked and paid for using the Entry Form, page 8. Seating will be limited, early booking is essential.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is the riders' responsibility to know the rules under which they compete

1. Rules: This event will be conducted in strict accordance with the current edition (including amendments) of: *EFA Dressage Rules & Official Procedures for Dressage Competition; FEI General Regulations, FEI Veterinary Regulations, FEI Dressage Rules, FEI Rules for World Cup Dressage; and FEI Rules for Young Rider World Cup Dressage*
2. Horses must be registered with, and owners and riders must be financial members of, the Equestrian Federation of Australia (EFA) in their State of residence, or if not Australian, with their respective national federation.
3. Riders in official competitions must be twelve years of age or over on the first day of the competition. Pony Dressage Riders may compete from the beginning of the year they turn 10.
4. Each horse entered must have the same rider as nominated on the entry form for all competitions at the Event. Any change of rider from the rider nominated on the entry form, must be notified before the Event commences.
5. Horses cannot be substituted after close of entries.
6. Eligibility of horses: Horses may only enter in two consecutive levels but no more than three tests, which may include a freestyle, may be ridden on a single day. Qualification is not required for general Championship competitions. For qualification requirements of CDI-W and CDI-Y competitions see pages 5 and 6.
7. Championship eligibility: To be eligible for a Champion award a competitor must ride in both tests at that level. Freestyle results at these levels will not count as Championship points.
8. Balloting: All Competitions will be kept to a maximum of 35 but these numbers may be reduced at the OC's discretion. The OC reserves the right to divide competitions, but only one Champion will be declared at each level. The OC reserves the right to ballot horses if necessary. A reserve list will be issued with the draw.
9. Entries must be received by COB on 13 April 2007. Omissions or mistakes in the entry form will result in the entry not being accepted. Telephone, emailed, faxed or late entries will not be accepted. Performance cards, registration cards and EFA membership cards must be available for checking by representatives of the OC during the event.
10. Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases, the OC reserve the right to retain up to 30% of the entry fees. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date and for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition. The administration fee will not be refunded after close of entries under any circumstances
11. Scratchings. Because of the reserve lists and possible distances to be travelled by reserve list riders, all riders are asked to consider their fellow competitors and notify the Event Director as soon as possible of their intention to withdraw.
12. Swabbing will take place at the Event. Attention is drawn to FEI Veterinary Rules. Supervision of horses is the sole responsibility of the owner/rider AT ALL TIMES.
13. Gear Check: Riders must present for a visual gear check at least ten minutes before they enter the arena for a test. Riders must stand their horses still while the visual check takes place. Competitors may be subjected to a detailed gear check after they have completed a test. This gear check is to ensure compliance with current EFA and FEI rules. It is not a safety check.
14. Protests: Refer to rule 1.3 in the EFA Dressage Rules and for CDI-W and CDI-Y Y competitors refer to Article 167 and 170 and the current FEI Rules. Objections must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$150.
15. Two Bridle Numbers must be worn at all times when the horse is out of the stable. All Queensland and Interstate dressage horses who have been allocated a bridle number by the EFA must quote this number on the entry form. Interstate/International horses who do not have an EFA bridle number will be allocated a temporary bridle number by the OC and will be required to supply their own equipment for this.
16. Tests in EFA competitions may be commanded including pony dressage competitions.
17. Hors concours (HC) entries will not be accepted in CDI-W or CDI-Y competitions but will be accepted in all other competitions at the event.
18. The OC reserves the right to accept or reject entries.
19. Private Sponsorship Logo: Riders may display the logo of their sponsor on their saddlecloth. The area covered by this logo may not exceed 200 sq cm. Labels on jackets must not exceed 12 sq.cm. at the height of the breast pocket.
20. A copy of the Start list will be posted on the web site after the close of entries. A copy of the draw will be posted to competitors and posted on the web site after close of entries.
21. GST information. Toowoomba Dressage Inc is not registered for GST and no GST has been charged in entry fees or is included in the prizemoney.
22. Safety headgear - AS/NZS 3838 (Current Australian Standard) refer Rule 3.2 and 3.1.8 EFA Dressage Rules effective 1st January 2004

CDN (National Grand Prix Competition No 23)

- The CDN Grand Prix is for competitors entering under EFA national rules and procedures. Combinations not taking part in the Grand Prix Freestyle (CDI-W) must enter the CDN Grand Prix competition.
- The CDN Grand Prix will be held immediately before the CDI-W Grand Prix.
- The CDN Grand Prix Freestyle will be held immediately before the CDI-W Freestyle.

Toowoomba Dressage Incorporated is proud to be associated with Dressage Queensland in the conduct of the 2007 Queensland CDI-W and for the first time in Queensland a CDI-Y for Young Riders.

The CDI-W is an international dressage event at Grand Prix level and is a World Cup Qualifier.

The CDI-Y is an international dressage event for Young Riders at Prix St Georges level and is a Young Rider World Cup Qualifier.

Whips	It is, under penalty of elimination, forbidden to carry a whip of any kind while competing in the arena. However, the use of one whip, with a total maximum length of 110 cm, in the practice area is allowed. The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena or the rider will entail a penalty of 4 points (= 1% in Freestyle tests) per judge. Upon arrival on the showground, only the rider when riding, walking, leading or lungeing a horse (lunge whip allowed) is allowed to carry a whip (maximum 110 cm) anywhere on the showgrounds. The groom may also walk, lead and lunge the horse as above. Other parties are allowed to carry a whip, provided it is not in connection with the training of the horse.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - FREESTYLE COMPETITIONS (Competitions 25, 26, 27, 28)

- The OC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry in the Freestyle. No refund will be made for any entry in the freestyle competitions after close of entries.
- The OC reserves the right to ballot if necessary in freestyle competitions. Refer condition 10.
- It is the responsibility of all competitors in the Freestyles to provide the CD and to ensure that the music is recorded at the correct sound level.
- Testing of Freestyle Music: Time will be available on Thursday evening for riders to test their freestyle music on the competition equipment. Time to be advised with start list/draw.

WELFARE OF THE HORSE - CODE OF CONDUCT

The Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) and Equestrian Federation of Australia (EFA) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's/EFA's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- The FEI/EFA urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise. A full copy of the Code can be obtained from the FEI, Avenue Mon-Repos 24, CH-1000, Lausanne 5, Switzerland. The code is available in English and French. The code is also available on the FEI's website: www.horsesport.org.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Presentations: Details of presentations will be notified in the draw. All riders and horses participating in the presentations are required to attend in formal riding attire. Riders and horses not suitably attired will not be permitted to participate in the formal presentations. At the discretion of the OC, riders who do not attend presentations may forfeit their prizes.

Prize Money: Where prize money is given place winners will receive their prize money by cheque in the mail following the competition. In the case of a tie, prize money will be allocated as per normal practice. (e.g. equal 1st place- the amount of prize money allocated for 1st and 2nd place is added together and divided by two or the number of horses which are equal). The OC reserves the right to substitute goods/vouchers to the value of the prizemoney or part thereof for any competition. The OC reserves the right to reduce the prizemoney for any competition (excl CDI-W and CDI-Y competitions) attracting less than 3 entries.

Stabling must be booked and paid for with entries. There will be a large number of safe undercover stables as well as a number of extra large panelled yards under cover. International rules require horses in CDI-W and CDI-Y (competitions 22, 24, 29, 31) to remain in the competition grounds for the duration of the event (*from the "trot-up" until the horse has finished competing*). Stables for CDI-W and CDI-Y horses will be allocated in the building to the west of the indoor arena. All stables will be numbered and allocated. A plan of the stable allocation will be included in the draw. Bedding sawdust is supplied on the grounds and in the stables, additional bedding can be added or purchased from the fodder merchant.

Camping. Onsite powered camping is available throughout the grounds. Areas will be noted on the site map sent out with the draw. Camping must be booked and paid for with entries and will not be allocated but available on a first in first served basis. Camping tickets will be sent out with the draw and **MUST** be placed on the windscreen of your vehicle or float for inspection. Any camp not displaying their camping tickets will be required to pay extra or vacate.

Catering A range of catering will be available at the competition venue including breakfast most mornings and evening meals on Friday and Saturday nights.
